ELITE Cabin Crew operate in a charter environment and find themselves flying from major Canadian cities to remote work camps in the arctic or to international locations.

We currently have openings in out Yellowknife base for part-time or full-time positions.

All ELITE Crew members are trained as an In-Charge crew member and act as member of an inflight team or on their own. The aircraft we operate on contain 50 to 100 seats.

What we offer:

What you require:

- Able to acquire Transport Canada security clearance, which includes a 5-year traceable history and clear criminal record. Crew members must possess and maintain a Transport Canada Restricted Area Identification Card as a condition of employment
- Able to get to the location of departure/employment, which is not always easily accessible by transit
- Flexibility to be available for scheduled reserve assignments 24/7, including nights, weekends, holidays, extended hours, on limited notice and/or be away from your home base for multiple days at a time
- Proven ability of working in a safety and team focused environment
- Possess exceptional interpersonal skills, exercise sound judgement and able to resolve conflicts with understanding and empathy
- Offer the highest standards of customer service, professionalism, personal integrity, professional image both in conduct and in appearance, including adherence to our uniform standards
- Effective communication by remaining calm, able to think and react quickly in the event of high-stress situations including but not limited to emergency evacuations, medical emergencies, delays, security threats, severe weather conditions including turbulence, passenger disturbances, etc.
- Must possess good physical agility and strength to assist customers, including the ability of lifting up to 50lbs, able to push and pull weighted moveable carts, able to walk/stand for extended periods of time
- Ability to pass a pre-employment drug screening
- Current certification in Standard First Aid Level C with CPR and AED is an asset.
